Starting Fresh: Our Plans for the New Year

PRAYER

We'll be starting the new year by setting our hearts to seek God as individuals and as a church family and by saturating the coming year in prayer. Specifically we're inviting YOU to join together in a 21 Day Daniel Fast.



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Identify any other activity that consumes a significant amount of our time Fasting allows us to use mealtime (preparation...) for prayer and meditation. You can fast from other activities to achieve the same effect.

What? Fasting is abstaining from food (mainly), drink or certain activities for spiritual purposes. As the name implies, a Daniel Fast is inspired by one of Scripture's great heroes of prayer, Daniel (see Daniel 10:2 - 3 and Daniel 1:8 - 16).

Who? This invitation to fast is extended to all OneTribers:) Whether you're a seasoned faster or new to this practice, consider this an opportune moment to draw nearer to God.

For parents and care givers, - this is an excellent opportunity to wisely and gradually introduce the children in your care to this biblical practice in age-appropriate ways.

P.S. If you have a health condition of any kind, please take this into account as you consider how to fast, and please consult your doctor if necessary.

How? There are many ways to fast. Find one that feels right for you, maybe chat to some friends about it or do your own bible study and research around it.

The Daniel Fast is a form of partial fasting, which means that it does not require a complete abstinence from food and drink. According to **Daniel 10:2**, **he** "ate no choice food; no meat or wine touched my lips..." However, you have the flexibility to adjust the level of your fasting as per your convenience.



When we fast, we should not only abstain from certain things but also spend time in prayer, reading the Bible, and meditating on it to draw closer to God (James 4:8).

Some **ideas of things to fast from** would include certain types of food, certain types of drink, social media/screen time, unwholesome talk, negativity (!)... if you would like to study more about this, **Isaiah 58:3 - 12** gives a helpful perspective on the kind of fasting that God honours.

When? The 21-day period aligns with Daniel's fast (there is no magic in the number). Starting on Monday 8th January to Sunday, the 28th, breaking the fast with special Worship and Prayer Services at 9 am and 11 am on the 28th.

Why? At OneTribe, our commitment to following Jesus is unwavering. Jesus Himself fasted, setting a precedent for His disciples (**Matt 6:16**). We fast to humble ourselves, to attune our hearts to God's voice, and to anticipate His kingdom breakthrough in our lives and within our church community.














